
A SENATE BILL FOR AN ACT

Appropriating the sum of \$59,980.00 and \$205,838.62 from the general fund for the fiscal years 2024 and 2025 respectively to augment the deficiency of the eight percent (8%) share for the Weno Municipal operations as mandate by Section 6 Article VIII of the Chuuk Constitution for the fiscal years 2024 and 2025 and its \$14,513.95 shares from 20% Revenue Shares previously appropriated and allocated for Weno Municipal, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Chuuk State Legislature:

1 **Section 1. Purpose.** This Act hereby appropriates the sum of \$59,980.00 and
2 \$205,838.62 from the general fund for the fiscal years 2024 and 2025 respectively to
3 augment the deficiency of the eight (8%) percent share for Weno Municipal operations for
4 the for fiscal years 2024 and 2025 as mandated by Section 6, Article VIII of the Chuuk State
5 Constitution and its \$14,513.95 shares from the 20% Revenue Shares previously
6 appropriated and allocated for Weno Municipal.


7 **Section 2. Appropriation.** The sum of \$59,980.00 and \$205,830.62 or so much
8 thereof from the general fund is hereby appropriated for the purpose of augmenting
9 deficiencies of the eight (8%) percent for Weno Municipal operations for the fiscal years
10 2024 and 2025 respectively and its \$14,513.95 shares from the 20% Revenue Shares
11 previously appropriated and allocated for Weno Municipal. The Governor shall be the
12 allottee of the funds.

13 **Section 3. Expenditure.** For the proper allocation, distribution and safeguard, the
14 funds shall be expended in accordance with the Chuuk State Constitution, Financial
15 Management Act, as amended, its implementing Rules and Regulations and any applicable
16 law.

17 **Section 4. Reporting.** The Governor through the Department of Administrative
18 Services shall submit a written report to the Chuuk State Legislature regarding the
19 expenditure of the funds appropriated herein within six (6) months after the fund is fully
20 expended.

21 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This act shall take effect upon approval by the Governor
22 or upon its becoming law without such approval.
