
A HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

Expressing deep sorrow and extending heartfelt condolences on behalf of the Eighteenth Chuuk State Legislature to the bereaved family, relatives and friends of the late Honorable Representative Johnny Robert for his untimely passing.

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Johnny Robert was born on April 18, 1973 on Weno,
2 Chuuk State; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Johnny Robert was married to Joyce Osawa Robert,
4 and they have four (4) children; two (2) sons and two (2) daughters; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Johnny Robert began his primary education at the
6 Tunnuk HeadStart School on Weno, Chuuk. He went on to attend P&P Elementary School
7 during his 1st to 2nd Grade years. The late Honorable Johnny Robert continued his educational
8 study at St. Cecelia Elementary School, Weno, Chuuk State from 3rd to 7th Grade. He
9 transferred and graduated from Lius P. Untalan Middle School at Barrigada, Guam. The late
10 Honorable Johnny Robert attended Berea Christian School from 9th to 10th Grade and he
11 continued his last high school years and graduated from Chuuk High School, Weno, Chuuk
12 State. He furthered his learning at the Job Corp for two (2) years and extended his studies at
13 the Hawaii Community College at Hilo, Hawaii.

14 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Johnny Robert devoted his life to public service as a
15 member of the Chuuk State Legislature House of Representative representing the Northern
16 Namoneas Region from 2019 to 2025; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Johnny Robert devoted four consecutive terms to the
18 Chuuk State Legislature, commencing with the Fifteenth Chuuk State Legislature, where he
19 distinguished himself as one of the top four members of the Resource and Development
20 Committee; and subsequently, across the Sixteenth, Seventeenth, and Eighteenth Chuuk State
21 Legislatures, he held critical posts on various Standing Committees including service on
22 Foreign and Federal Affairs and Judiciary and Governmental Operations; rising to Vice
23 Chairman of Foreign and Federal Affairs; and culminating his tenure by leading as the
24 Chairman of the House Committee on Health and Welfare, thereby advancing key policies

1 that profoundly impacted the health, public resources, and well-being of the Chuukese people;
2 and

3 **WHEREAS**, in addition and prior to his dedication to public service, late Honorable
4 Johnny Robert worked for the Department of Administrative Services, Chuuk State; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Johnny was an influential leader who contributed to
6 the development of his communities on Weno and the whole State of Chuuk. The late
7 Honorable Johnny Robert be dearly missed by many; and

8 **WHEREAS**, late Honorable Johnny Robert was called to his eternal rest at the Chuuk
9 State Hospital in the early morning of September 28, 2025; now therefore


10 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the House of Representatives, Eighteenth Chuuk State
