
A SENATE BILL FOR AN ACT

Establishing a uniform provision to all Boards, Commissions and Agencies whose member resign or whose term expires shall be authorized a grace period to continue for a period of three (3) months, and for other purposes.

Be enacted in the Chuuk State Legislature:

1 Section 1. Purpose. We have noticed that most boards, commissions and agencies
2 established by law lacks the provision of a grace period to continue serving as members of
3 the Boards, Commissions and Agencies once their member resign or once their term expires.
4 As a result of this, confusion and intense legal arguments are unavoidable. To address this, it
5 is imperative that the law should be explicit as to the grace period for a member to continue
6 to serve as members of the Boards, Commissions and Agencies who resign or whose term
7 expires.

8 Section 2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, members of any Boards,
9 Commission and Agencies who resign or whose term expires is authorized to continue the
10 serving as member of any Boards or Commissions for a period of three (3) months. Within
11 the said period, the Governor shall nominate to the Senate the replacement of the resigned or
12 expired member of any Board, Commission or Agencies.

13 Section 3. Vacancy. Vacancy is created in any Board, Commission or Agency when
14 any member dies, resigns, removed or whose term expired.

15 Section 4. Notification. The Board, Commission or Agency whose member died,
16 resign, removed or whose term expired, shall notify in writing to the Governor within ten
17 (10) days of such occurrence of the event.

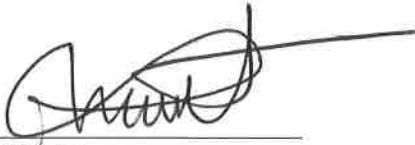
10 Section 6. Effective Date. This act shall become effective after the approval by the
